“Japonisme”

“Fairfield Duo: Japonisme” celebrates the explosion of interest in Japanese arts and music that swept Europe in the late 19th century. That explosion happily coincided with French Impressionism so the Duo will present music of Ibert, Debussy, Satie, and Ravel plus Japanese selections -some of which will be played on shakuhachi, the traditional Japanese bamboo flute.
